



FTA Trail Crew Members Job Description

WANTED: Trail Crew for the Fernie Trails Alliance.

The trail network in Fernie, BC is one of the biggest assets in our community. The FTA is looking to hire up to 4 keen, hard-working people, to assist the Trail Crew Supervisor with the 2026 trail maintenance program.

This person will be:

- Looking to spend the summer outdoors being physically active
- An avid trail user (hiker, trail runner, cyclist, etc.) and familiar with the trail network
- Happy to work as part of a team
- Self-motivated and able to work unsupervised
- Hard working, enthusiastic and willing to learn
- Permanent resident (resident of the Columbia Basin required)

The Position will include:

- Reporting to the Trail Crew Supervisor and assisting in day-to-day operations
- Using hand tools and basic power tools such as shovel, hoe and brush saw
- Completing trail maintenance such as repairs from water erosion and brushing
- Building new trails/reroutes
- Working with volunteer trail builders
- Providing assistance at FTA events, when needed
- Properly utilizing all safety equipment required in the performance of daily activities
- Maintaining and caring for FTA tools and equipment in an acceptable manner

We are looking to start our trail maintenance program in the Spring of 2026.

While there is some flexibility in the schedule, the successful applicant will be willing to commit to 32-40 hrs per week for a period of 9-25 weeks. Pay will be \$18.25 per hour based on experience/competency.
